To use the tariff, you have to activate after the initial balance charge. Every 5 days, your megabytes and minutes are renewed, as long as you have enough balance. For information purposes, the equivalent monthly fee (30 days) would be €90.

Every time you renew the fee of your tariff, you will enjoy the following: 50 minutes for talking from Spain with mobiles and landlines from 43 countries and landlines from:11 countries. Check the destinations included in www.orange.es or in www.simmundo.es. Maximum of 150 different destinations per month.

If the 50 minutes are used up or if the 5 days have elapsed and you do not renew the benefits of your tariff: National calls for €25 cents/min. + 32 cents € of establishment calls and international calls originating from Spain from €1 cent/min. + 32 cents € of establishment, of call (VAT included).

Premium rate services (80x, 90x, Premium SMS/MMS) and international tariffs are excluded. Once the roaming GB included in your tariff has been exceeded, the maximum regulated price will be applied, which is €0.0018/MB.

Duration, renewal and termination

Prepaid Cards will be valid for 6 months from the moment the first call or connection is made, the last balance recharge is made, or from the last balance consumption. Once this period has expired, calls may be received for a period of one additional month before we deactivate the SIM. During that month, to avoid deactivation of the SIM, which entails the loss of the assigned telephone number, it is necessary to make at least one recharge.
